



UPDATED PHONE GUIDELINES

MOBILE PHONES AT SIENA COLLEGE

THE COLLEGE'S POSITION ON CELL PHONE USE:

Cell phone use is permitted, but it is not to be used as a distraction from class or other college activities. Cell phone use is prohibited during class time, in the library, in the dining hall, and in the residence halls.

All cell phone use is prohibited during class time, from 8:40 a.m. to 3:20 p.m., and during all college events and activities.

No cell phone use is permitted during the first 15 minutes of class time, and during the last 15 minutes of class time.

Prohibited cell phone use includes using a cell phone to text, browse the internet, or use social media during class time, in the library, in the dining hall, and in the residence halls.

Texting is prohibited during class time, in the library, in the dining hall, and in the residence halls.

RECESS AND LUNCHTIME

Students are permitted to use their cell phones during recess and lunchtime, but they are not to be used as a distraction from class or other college activities.

Mobile phone use is prohibited during the first 15 minutes of class time, and during the last 15 minutes of class time.

Texting is prohibited during class time, in the library, in the dining hall, and in the residence halls.
